



## 34th Anniversary Match

### STAGE 1

#### Pistol caliber rifle & 2 SAA Pistols April 2026



### 10 PISTOL, 10 RIFLE (pistol caliber)

**Staging** Rifle on the table, Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each, staged on the table.

**Gun Sequence:** Pistols first, then Rifle, Start at the ready.

**At the Beep:** With the pistols, engage the smaller circle target at 30 yards first with 5 rounds. Then engage the large diamond target at 50 yards for the other 5 rounds. Pistols may be either holstered or placed on the table after use. Then, with the Rifle, engage the large diamond target at 50 yards first for 5 rounds. Then engage the large square target at 80 yards with the other 5 rounds.

- Notes:**
1. All targets are engaged standing and unsupported.
  2. Loading and unloading will be done at the table.
  3. Scoring will be the number of hits with time used as the tie breaker.
  4. Any SASS legal bullet may be used. Main match velocity limits **do not** apply.
  5. 22 caliber is allowed for this stage.




Rifle caliber rifle

April 2026




(80 yards)

10 PISTOL, 5 RIFLE (rifle caliber)

**Staging** Rifle on the table, Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each, staged on the table. (NO 22 caliber)

**Gun Sequence:** Rifle first, then Pistols, Start at the ready.


**At the Beep:** With the Rifle, engage the large square target at 80 yards with 5 rounds. Then, with the Pistols, engage the large diamond target at 50 yards with 5 rounds first, then engage the smaller circle target at 30 yards with the other 5 rounds. Pistols may be either holstered or placed on the table after use.

- Firearms Notes:**
1. Any SASS Cowboy or Wild Bunch legal rifle caliber Rifle may be used. This includes single shot, lever or bolt action rifle (refer to SASS or WBAS Handbooks).
  2. Single shot rifles will be staged empty with action opened and ammunition staged anywhere safely.
  3. Each class of rifle will be scored in it's own category. A shooter may choose to run this stage using all 3 classes of rifle (single shot, lever, bolt), time permitting.
  4. When choosing ammunitions for this event, please note that the max. target distance is 80 yards. Spectators, participants and TO's (and targets) will appreciate powder charges that are reduced in power and more appropriate for this "shorter" long range event.

### STAGE 3

Rifle caliber rifle  
& (1) 1911 Pistol  
April 2026



**10 PISTOL, 5 RIFLE (rifle caliber)**

**Staging** Rifle on the table, 1911 Pistol holstered with (1) 5 round loaded magazine inserted and (1) 5 round loaded magazine on your person

**Gun Sequence:** Rifle first, then Pistol, Start at the ready.

**At the Beep:** With the Rifle, engage the large square target at 80 yards with 5 rounds. Then, with the Pistol, engage the large diamond target at 50 yards with 5 rounds first, then engage the smaller circle target at 30 yards with the other 5 rounds.

**Firearms Notes:** 1. Any SASS Cowboy or Wild Bunch legal Lever Rifle or Bolt action Rifle may be used.

2. Each class of rifle will be scored in it's own category. A shooter may choose to run this stage using both classes of rifle (lever, bolt), with time permitting.

3. When choosing ammunitions for this event, please note that the max. target distance is 80 yards. Spectators, participants and TO's (and targets) will appreciate powder charges that are reduced in power and more appropriate for this "shorter" long range event.

**1911 Notes:** 1. Pistol MUST be brought to the line holstered with hammer down on an empty chamber and first 5 round magazine inserted.

2. First magazine will be inserted at the loading table and the pistol will not be drawn from the holster and charged until it is needed for use on this stage.

3. 1911 will be cleared on the firing line by the TO and will only be re-holstered after the pistol is called clear.
